Newer varieties seem to be preferred over the tried-and-true heirloom.

Rush was mentioned by one grower as a summer squash instead of zucchini. Gold Rush is a 1980 AAS Edible – Vegetable winner "with the shape and taste of zucchini:" as stated on AAS winner's website. Sold as a zucchini by several seed companies. Isn't it interesting that a squash can be sold under various identities? Goldern Glory was attacked the most by squash bugs for one grower.

There was some early blight on all varieties for one grower and only Matt's Wild Cherry for another grower. But production was still high on all varieties clear to frost. My experience was germination of all seeds except for one seed of Lemon Drop. One grower had germination difficulty except for Cherry Bomb. Another grower had difficulty picking Cherry Bomb without tearing tomato so harvested clusters. The rankings were very close: 2.0 to 2.7. One comment was "all varieties grew well, tasted delicious and produced tremendous amounts of produce."
